

AN IMPORTANT MESSAGE ABOUT YOUR RECYCLING - WE NEED YOUR HELP!

Thank you for recycling, but unfortunately the material left in your recycle bin **CANNOT BE RECYCLED** in our curbside collection program. Please place the items in regular household garbage. For assistance, please call the Solid Waste Division at 407.688.5089 or email: Emily.McCabe@Sanfordfl.gov

The following items **ARE** accepted in the curbside recycling program - please rinse out all containers & discard lids:

- Pasteboard (i.e., cereal boxes, empty paper towel & toilet paper rolls, soda boxes, beer boxes, tissue boxes, gift boxes, pizza boxes and shoe boxes)
- Brown paper grocery bags (no wax, no wet strength material, no liners)
- Corrugated cardboard (flattened and cut down to fit inside the recycle bin)
- Newspaper, supplements, magazines and catalogs
- Box board, Carrier stock, White and Colored paper
- Plastic containers #1-7 (#'s on bottom of containers) Remove all lids
- Glass bottles and jars (clear, green and brown) Remove all lids
- Aluminum cans, Steel cans and Tin household containers, such as food cans
- Telephone books



The following items **ARE NOT** included in the curbside recycling program:

- Plastic bags
- Plastic cups
- Wax-lined Paper Cups and Plates
- Motor oil or Pesticide containers
- Light bulbs or Drinking glassware
- Aluminum foil or Pie plates
- Paint or Pesticide cans
- Electronic devices
- Styrofoam trays/egg cartons
